STEP 2

LEARN THE BASICS

FIRST 3 MONTHS

Do not begin by obsessing over money. Begin by learning the basics of YouTube and how to make videos people want to watch.

Until you can make binge worthy videos, it will be difficult to build a side income.

Learning leads to pattern recognition. Pattern recognition comes from creating consistently over time.

STEP 3

CONCENTRATE ON CONTENT

FIRST 6 MONTHS

In 1996, Bill Gates wrote, “Content is King.”

That is still true. But on YouTube, content alone is not enough. Content becomes income when it creates trust.

People often decide quickly whether they trust a creator. Sustainable trust, however, is built over time through repeated videos and clear communication.

TRUST BUILDING CONTENT

1. Be Authentic

Do not perform a fake version of yourself.

2. Tell Your Story

People trust a real person, not just information.
